

Weekly Project

The Weekly Project is an extra credit assignment that is available every two to three weeks. These will generally be challenging and may be unrelated to the content in class or an extension of the topics in class. There may even be times that you are not explicitly taught the knowledge required to complete the assignment. This is intentional to challenge you.

I will offer advice on extra credit assignments, but I will not tutor or teach it to you.

If you have an idea and want to bounce ideas, I would love to help.

If you want to know if you're right or how to do it, I won't help.

These weekly projects will count towards different categories, so read them to see which category it counts for! This first project will be worth extra credit points in participation AND homework. To give a feel for how much this is worth, homework assignments are worth 50pts each and participation is 10 pts per day. This project will be available for two weeks and is worth 32pts to homework and 8pts to participation.

The first weekly assignment is to send me an email. All of my assignments will have my email address at the top right corner of the page. If you have questions throughout the year on assignments, you want to inform me about absences or you have found something interesting you would like to share then you can email me and I will get back to you, usually within twenty-four hours.

This email should be formatted correctly to award full points. The email should have the following parts:

- An appropriate subject line that describes the general contents of the email (Weekly Project #1, for example)
- An Introduction (Hello, Dear , etc.)
- A Body that describes the purpose of the email/contains any necessary information
- A Closing line (Thanks, Best, See you Tuesday, etc.)
- Your name at the end

In your email you should tell me a few things:

1. What is your feeling towards math and learning going into this year? (Do you like math? Do you think you will need math? Why?)
2. Are there any concerns you have about the class?
3. What is a hobby or interest of yours?

Feel free to add anything else you would like. The email should be sent by Sunday, August 25th at 11:59pm. Please be sure to CC one of your parents or guardians.
